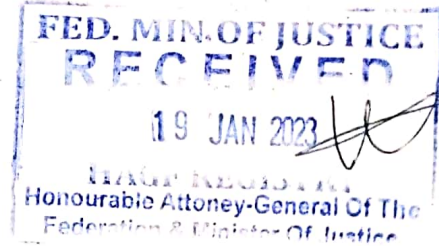

REPORT ON NATIONAL ORIENTATION AGENCY FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2022

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 In the drive towards ensuring that government business is carried out in a transparent and fair manner, the Agency has since imbibed the culture of a due process as laid down in the extant rules guiding government business.
- 1.2 In view of the foregoing, the Freedom of Information Desk in the Agency wish to forward to the Office of the Attorney-General for the Federation NOA's FOI report containing the required information as set forth by the FOIA Report Sheet.

2.0 Number and nature of determinations made which resulted in a refusal to disclose information and reasons for such determinations.

- 2.1 There were no determinations made which resulted in a refusal to disclose information and reasons for such determinations

3.0 Number of appeals made by persons under the Act and reasons for the actions that led to the appeal.

- 3.1 There were no appeals made under this category in the period under review.
