# REPORT ON NATIONAL ORIENTATION AGENCY FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR 2022

### 1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 In the drive towards ensuring that government business is carried out in a transparent and fair manner, the Agency has since imbibed the culture of a due process as laid down in the extant rules guiding government business.
